Beginning String Camp

Open to flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, French horn, trumpet, trombone, tuba, timpani, percussion, harp, piano, violin, viola, cello and bass. Included in the camp is a concert on June 28 with members of the New Horizons Chamber Orchestra.
